Third parties with express authorization and permitted by law may be granted access to your information. If a bank application is completed as part of a refund application, these details are available for evaluation by the lending bank as part of the preparation and processing of you tax return.

Credit card payments require the credit Card Processing Company to have access to your credit card information and will be subject to their credit card privacy policy. Rushmore Tax may solicit you with offers or services we may launch from time to time.

The processing company through which we transmit your tax return to the IRS and local and state tax authorities will have access to your tax return information.
